Chris Dingli trained at Webber Douglas Academy of Dramatic Arts in London. He has spent the last decade in the UK working as an actor in a large number of Shakespeare plays, musicals and other productions in London and Europe.

His stage and film work has seen him work with some of the world's most recognisable names including Michael Bay, Rachel Weisz, Alejandro Amenábar, John Krasinski and Linda Gray.

His screen credits include *13 Hours: The Secret Soldiers of Benghazi*, *Doctors* (BBC), *Agora* and *Sinbad* (SKY). He starred in and was head writer of the TV series *Comedy Knights TV Shorts*.

His comedy credits include co-writing and starring in the hugely popular annual show *The Comedy Knights*, and the improvised trilogy *Dingle Bells Malcolm Smells*. He was also a writer and founding member of the Youtube comedy channel *The Hard Comedy*.

His original one-man comedy *Bad Dad* has played to both critical and audience acclaim, receiving 5 star reviews in London and Malta. It will tour the UK in the fall of 2016, before heading to the US in 2017.

His March 2016 *Stand Up Comedy Special* played to a packed house. He continues to headline stand up comedy evenings and is a very much in demand as a host and MC for events. In 2016 he was Master of Ceremonies at the Valletta Film Festival.

Other work includes writing and directing the circus show *Darirari* for CirkuMalta (Malta Arts Festival) and *The Hogwallops* (Edinburgh Festival and UK tour).

Chris is the host of *The Big Drive Home* on Xfm 100.2 and throughout the summer is performing as Lonny in the original Maltese cast of *Rock of Ages*.

He currently divides his time between Malta and the UK.
